March 4, 2015 Geneva, IL – **John A. Cunningham**, Kane County Clerk, reminds Kane County residents that the **last day** to register to vote for the **April 7, 2015 Consolidated Election is Tuesday, March 10, 2015**. This Consolidated Election will involve all of Kane County. The County Clerk's office is open **Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM**. In addition, most libraries, municipal, and township offices in Kane County do accept registrations.

- Grace Period Registration for the **Consolidated Election** will be available **in the Kane County Clerk's Office Only** from **Wednesday, March 11, 2015** until **Saturday, April 4, 2015**. Once registered, this voter will cast their ballot during grace period for the Consolidated Election. Two forms of current identification are required.
- Early Voting for the Consolidated Election will begin on **Monday, March 23, 2015** through **Saturday, April 4, 2015**. See the Kane County Clerk's website for details.

Registration will resume on **Thursday, April 8, 2015**.

The Kane County Clerk's Voter Registration Office is located in Building B at the Kane County Government Center, 719 South Batavia Avenue (Route 31), Geneva.

To register, a person must be a United States citizen, 18 years old on or before the date of the next election, a resident of the precinct for 30 days prior to the election, and provide two forms of identification, one of which shows their current name and address.
